**REQUIREMENTS**

- Minimum rating of 2+ on American Sign Language Proficiency Interview (Contact Dr. Donald Grushkin, Program Coordinator, to schedule ASLPI Interview. For best testing results, it is suggested to wait until the course has been completed before taking the ASLPI Interview. Dr. Grushkin's email address is [grushkind@csus.edu] and his office is located in EUR-312)
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in each of the four courses for receipt of the Certificate
- Students are required to have completed at least 7 units of ASL, including EDS 153, at CSUS in order to receive a Certificate.

**Required Coursework**

EDS 150 Beginning American Sign Language 1A (3 Units)

EDS 151 Beginning American Sign Language 1B (3 Units)

**Prerequisite: EDS 150 or equivalent**

EDS 152 Intermediate American Sign Language (4 Units)

**Prerequisite: EDS 151 or equivalent**

EDS 153 Advanced ASL: Instructing and Informing (4 units)

**Prerequisite: EDS 152 or equivalent**

**Deadline to apply for the certificate: November 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall    April 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring**
